### **May 4<sup>th</sup>: Navigator PREP Launches Final Three-Month Track**

Open to current seniors and juniors in high school, Navigator PREP begins its final track for the 2019-2020 academic year. Navigator PREP is the country's first virtual transition program that works with students and parents on the executive functioning, social integration, and emotional regulation skills necessary to succeed in a college environment. This May, we expanded Navigator PREP due to Covid-19 offering both our individualized support for seniors with a modified program where students and parents can access our virtual webinars. Finally, a new program was designed to help juniors better prepare for the college search process.

### **May 16<sup>th</sup> Admissions Virtual Open House**

Join Beacon College's President, Dr. George Hagerty; Provost, Dr. Shelly Chandler; Dean of Student Affairs, Dr. Kerry Greenstein; Director of the Center for Student Success, Sheryl Nichols; Director of the Transition Center, Alex Morris-Wood; Director of Corporate and Academic Outreach, Esteban Lopez; and the Beacon College Admissions and Financial Aid staff as they provide an overview of the College and its programs. There will be ample opportunities for questions and answers. In addition the Open House will offer a virtual tour of campus and a walk through of Beacon's soon to open residence, exclusively reserved for new students entering in fall 2020.

### **June 1<sup>st</sup>: Summer for Success Preparation Webinars Begin**

Over the month of June, webinars will be provided to our Summer for Success students and parents to help prepare for the three-week college immersion program. The four sessions will focus on better understanding our support model, preparation for dorm life, problem-solving, and the overall college transition.

**July 12<sup>th</sup>: Summer for Success Begins**

We are excited to launch our *Summer for Success* program, a three-week college immersion experience to help prepare current tenth, eleventh, and twelfth grade students for university life! We are thrilled to bring in 85 students to take three academic courses, partake in student clubs, and participate in off-campus trips.

**July 30<sup>th</sup>: Summer for Success Closing Dinner**

Before move-out, our students and summer staff gather for one final celebration! With a performance from students, certificates awarded by the President of Beacon College, a sit-down dinner, and DJ, our 85 students will use this time to say good-bye and dance the night away!

**July 31<sup>st</sup>: Summer for Success Concludes**

Students will be departing campus by 12:00 PM and should be on the lookout for their *Performance Evaluation and Transition Recommendation Report* that outlines how the student functioned in *Summer for Success* with concrete suggestions to prepare for the transition to college.

**August 15<sup>th</sup>: Navigator PREP Concludes**

Navigator PREP concludes with nearly 100 participants, as students who participated in the full program receive and process through their *Transition Report*, the comprehensive report of their participation in the program that if attending Beacon College, gets dispersed and reviewed with our Center for Student Success, Counseling Center, and Student Life staff.

**September 1<sup>st</sup>: Navigator PREP Early Move-In & Celebratory Dinner**

Beacon College students entering in the Fall of 2020 who completed Navigator PREP are welcome to move in early! Come complete your final steps for registration, settle into your new dorm room, and get to know students before the rest of campus arrives.
