Guidelines for Admission

Admission Requirements

Applicants for admission to Beacon College must submit the following to the Office of Admissions:

1. Completed Application for Admission, together with a non-refundable application fee of \$50.00.
2. An official high school transcript with documentation of a standard diploma or GED.
3. Official transcripts from any colleges attended, if applicable.
4. *Credits earned at Beacon College are transferrable, however current Beacon students who are transferring to another college OR visiting college students should always check with the receiving institution to confirm acceptance of earned course credits.*
5. A recent psycho-educational evaluation that provides evidence of a learning disability, ADHD, or other academic-based challenges and struggles. The date of the report should be less than three years from the current date and include a cognitive assessment conducted by a licensed psychologist, neuropsychologist, school psychologist, or a certified school psychologist.
6. Personal interview: On-campus, telephone, or Skype interviews can be arranged for prospective students.
7. Instructor or counselor recommendations: Please submit recommendation letters from a teacher, professor or guidance/college counselor who knows you well. If you need, we can supply you with a recommendation form to distribute to the educator(s) of your choice.

Admission Criteria

The Beacon College Admissions Team conduct a highly individualized assessment of each candidate's application and documentation. Criteria for admission includes:

- Diagnosis of a specific learning disability or ADHD, or demonstration of an academic-based challenge or struggle.
- Candidates must be socially mature and have demonstrated motivation to complete the academic requirements of an accredited college. These qualities are assessed in interviews with the professional staff and through psychological evaluations.
