Eligibility:

Meet the following three criteria:

- 1) Documented financial need
- 2) Perseverance and courage leading to a record of academic achievement that transcends their learning challenges
- 3) Eligibility to enter the sophomore or junior year at Beacon College
- 4) There is no minimum cumulative G.P.A. requirement

Awards:

One \$1,000 award will be made during the 2021-2022 academic year.
