Eligibility:

Meet the following three criteria:

- 1) Documented financial need
- 2) Perseverance and a record of academic achievement that transcends their learning challenges
- 3) Current or newly accepted student for the 2022-2021 academic year

Awards:

Four \$2,500 awards will be issued.

Application Requirements:

Applicants must assume responsibility for all requirements. Incomplete or inaccurate applications will not be considered.

- 4) Personal statement of financial need (e.g. Why do you need the scholarship?) – Statements should be typed (not handwritten) and no longer than two pages.
