## Scholarship for Perseverance

3. Demonstrated financial need based on the FAFSA.

**Awards:**

1 (\$5000) Non-renewable scholarship will be awarded for the Spring 2023 term.

**Application Deadline:**

All application materials must be received in the Financial Aid Office by **January 2, 2023.**

**Applicant Requirements:**

Applicant must assume responsibility for all requirements. Incomplete or inaccurate applications will not be considered.

2. Unofficial copy of Beacon College transcripts, and
3. Personal statement of persistence in spite of adversity (see Eligibility Criteria, Item 2). Statements should be typed (not hand-written) and no longer than two pages in length.
